



Maps for Scraps: StarQuar & Beyond Supply List

Welcome to StarQuar Scrap Quilts! Let's use our scraps to build a beautiful starry sky. **Please read this entire document.**

Here's what you'll need:

- Scraps of lights, mediums and darks, minimum size 2½" x 2½"
- Marking tools: mechanical pencil, light-colored chalk pencil
- Small ruler for marking (square, rectangular or half-inch wide is fine)
- Sewing machine
- Neutral colored thread, sharp fabric shears (big scissors)
- Rotary cutting supplies to cut up your scraps
- Iron and ironing surface
- Design wall or board is very helpful!

Pre cutting:

These blocks are all made from just one patch size: 2½" x 2½". Before class, cut your scraps into 2½" x 2½" squares. You can also cut up fat quarters or yardage or Jelly Rolls into these squares, but variety is the key! You can choose a color scheme or you can use all the colors together.

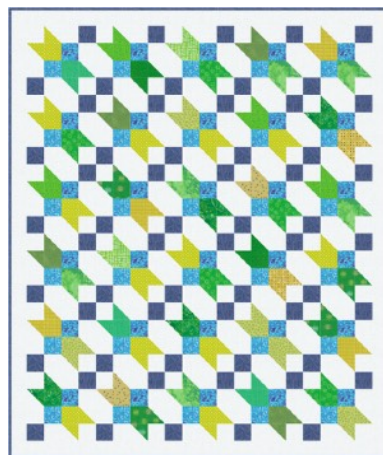
Good to know: It takes a total of 6 squares to make one StarQuar unit. I often use 3 of one color and 3 of a different **contrasting** color. All 3 squares do not have to match.

Managing scraps:

I'll share many ideas for how your StarQuars can be used to make interesting, beautiful, unique quilts that are practically free because you've used your leftovers! Several patterns are included with the class. Additional designs will be available for purchase.
