## Corded Log Cabins

This project adds dimension to the classic Log Cabin block, giving it a fresh appeal. The block lends itself to many projects. Learn Lisa's process to create single blocks, multi-block projects, quilt borders and other creative accents!

During class, students will make one block approximately 12" with borders.

*Recommendation:* If you are **not** using a jelly roll, all your fabrics should be cut into 2.5" strips prior to the start of class.

### SUPPLY LIST:

- 12 to 15 2.5" wide fabric strips, your own fabrics OR African prints\*. The more variety you have, the easier it is to design!
- Coordinating base fabric for the center, 5" square
- 3 yds of 3/8" wide cotton cording filler \*\*
- Batting, at least 16" square
- Sewing machine in good working order
- ZIPPER FOOT
- Basic sewing supplies (thread, scissors, pins, seam ripper, etc. A stiletto is also helpful for this technique.)
