25" Square of Dark Blue (or your favorite Solid) loose weave fabric for background

NOTE: if creating appliqué center bring additional supplies: Freezer paper, 3 FQ for flowers

NOTIONS & EQUIPMENT:

Clover white Chacopy (or similar white dressmaker tracing paper)

Amazon: Clover New 24-141 Chakopie, Single sided White

Japanese Sashiko Needles or #22 Chenille Sharp end Needles

1 skein of Japanese Sashiko thread -or- 1 skein of #5 White Pearl Cotton -or-

1 skein of white DMC embroidery floss

Tracing wheel -or- Clover Tracing Pen -or- pen with no ink!

White marking tool: Charo liner – white marking pen

Quilting thread to match background fabric

Thimble (if you use one!)

Pins or Sew-Tites

Scissors (embroidery, if adding applique flower, need a larger pair of scissors)
