## **Boutique Consignment Pricing Guidelines (2025 Show)**

Below are general suggestions/guidelines to use when pricing your **CONSIGNMENT** items to be sold in the RNQG Quilt Show Boutique. When determining a price for your consigned item, consider its original retail value, current condition, and its general appeal/popularity in today's market. Search online for current item value if you don't know it already. People shopping at the Boutique are looking for a bargain so resist overpricing – think "yard sale" prices, especially for used items. Pricing should always be in dollar amounts, no cents e.g., \$1, \$2, ... \$8, etc.

## FABRIC "BUNDLES": (NOTE: No fabric will be cut at the Boutique.)

- ALL Fabric must be packaged securely into a "BUNDLE", associated with 1 sales tag.
- The smallest piece of fabric in a Bundle is 1/8 Yard Width Of Fabric (WOF)...OR a Fat Quarter. Fabric pieces smaller than this belong in a "Scrap Bag" (see below).
- Per BUNDLE Minimum yardage = ONE YARD
- Per BUNDLE Maximum yardage = THREE YARDS
- Bundle Examples:
  - Eight, 1/8 yd. WOF pieces of fabric = total: 1 yd. (minimum)
  - Twelve, fat quarters = total: 3 yds. (maximum)
- Suggested Pricing (based on individual pieces in a bundle):
  - 1/8 yd. piece: approximately \$1 +/-
  - 1/4 yd./Fat Quarter: \$1-\$2
  - 1/2 yd. piece: \$2-\$4
  - 3/4 yd. piece: \$3-\$6
  - 1 yd. piece: \$4-\$8 (scale pricing accordingly for larger, single-cuts up to the 3 yd. maximum)

## FABRIC "SCRAP BAGS":

• These are either Quart or Gallon size Ziploc Baggies containing fabric pieces smaller than what would qualify for a Bundle but bigger than approximately 2.5" X 2.5", filled to approximately 80% volume.

Gallon Bags: \$6-\$8Quart Bags: \$4-\$6

**HANDMADE ITEMS:** Typical of this category are Wall Hangings, Table Runners/Placemats, Baby Items, Bags/Purses of all sizes, Bowl Cozies, Throw/Baby Quilts, etc.. They sell for a lot less than they are truly worth, but priced too high won't sell. Due to the variability in size/complexity/quality of any handmade item, we suggest you try to find a similar item online (e.g., Etsy, Mercari, Ebay, etc.). Then price your similar item 25% to 50% less (online retailers get a fraction of the list price).

PATTERNS: Recommend approximately 30% of retail. No more than 50% of retail value.

**BOOKS**: \$1 - \$5. Current relevancy is a big pricing factor in this category.

**NOTIONS**: No more than 50% of retail value depending on the condition, age, and current popularity/relevancy. Items in this category include, but are not limited to, Quilting rulers, mats, rotary cutters, unique quilting tools, thread, etc.

<u>MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS</u>: Set price at no more than 50% of retail value depending on the condition, age, and current popularity/relevancy. This category captures everything else (e.g., mini ironing board, sewing machine, Ott Light, etc.) that doesn't belong in another category. Consider pricing approximately 30% of retail if lovingly used but in good condition.

## For further consideration

**MAGAZINES**: Magazines are accepted only as DONATIONS (no Sales Tag and no inventory form) and are not returned.

MINI (POSTCARD) QUILTS: All Mini (Postcard) 5" X 8" quilts are DONATED to RNQG and become the property of the guild for pricing and sale at the show and/or future guild-related events. The Boutique chairs will attach a Sales Tag. No Inventory form needed.
