

This tutorial use Terial Spray, but you don't need to use that product, but starch is recommended, it actually helps with assembly and leaves the star with a bit more body.

This tutorial is a great way to get familiar with the rope/clothesline items that are so popular. The techniques are all the same, but starting with a coaster with no fabric wrapping is a great way to learn the technique and build from there.

An easy and great tutorial with pattern. In the tutorial she uses a flannel fabric, but cotton, or terry cloth works great too, no change to the instructions.

** NOTE ** To get to the download, page down on the link for the pattern. You will have to enter your email address to receive access to the downloadable pattern. It will print on 2-3 pages and will have to be taped together. Use a card stock if you have available, otherwise copy paper is fine.

These are easy and no pattern required, super fast to make and nice gift for a baby shower.

Easy bib pattern, you do not have to use snaps, can you Velcro instead. It can also be made in all cotton or terry cloth or flannel, you decide.

** **NOTE** ** You don't need polyurethane laminate (PUL) fabric, unless you want to. The PUL will help with not keeping baby dry.
