Important RNQG Website and Email Communication Changes – Action Required!

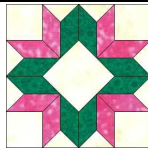
We've modernized our website and email communications. Please read the following important changes to ensure you don't miss any guild announcements, newsletters, or Zoom invitations.

Action Required: If you haven't received or accepted an invitation to join the Google group email list, please reach out to one of the board members ASAP. We want to ensure every member is connected and informed.

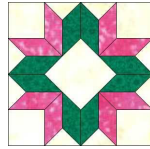

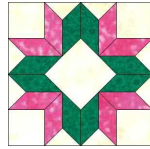

I will take isolette quilts and juvenile pillowcases throughout the year. Please let me know if you need any of the 100% cotton batting.

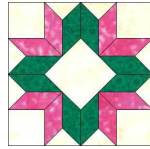

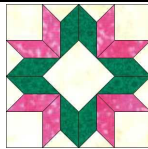
