I constructed this thread catcher based on a gift that a dear friend gave me a long time ago. Many variations are available, so feel free to add your own touches!



TAKE-HOME INSTRUCTIONS: An instructional document will be provided so you can make more thread catchers at home.

SUPPLIES:

- Fabrics of your choice—the examples show two or three different fabrics for the inside, outside, and pincushion. You decide how you want it to look.
- Sewing machine in good operable condition.
- Usual sewing supplies
- Thread colors of your choice

THE FOLLOWING WILL BE PROVIDED AT THE WORKSHOP

- 4" bathroom ceramic tile or other item for weight.
- Doll stuffing for pincushion
- Clear plastic tablecloth or substitute
- Clothesline or other stiffener for rim of bag
- Plastic shelf liner, bumpy type.

PREPARATION: PLEASE CUT

- Main fabric for bag 8" x 16"
- Main fabric for pincushion, 7" square
- Lining for bag 8" x 16"
- Optional plastic liner for the bag, 8" x 16"—only if you are using your own plastic. Plastic will be supplied at the workshop.
- Coordinating fabric for pincushion bottom 6" square
- Two strips of coordinating fabric for the straps, 2.5" x 4"
